#### PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

The Challenge is NOW OPEN! Students must complete their online Reading Record by 20 August 2021 to complete the Challenge. Students in Years 3 - 6 should complete their online Reading Record independently. They will be shown how to do this at school. However, students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 are not expected to do this - we will enter the data for these students. Nevertheless if parents would like to complete the online Reading Record we can give you the specific password. These passwords are not yet available from the PRC. Kindergarten parents will receive further information regarding the Challenge. All students will be given a paper copy of the Reading Record as well. This is an easy way to keep count of the number of books read. Parents will be asked to sign
