At Mass last weekend, St Oliver's launched our fundraising mission 'Hope Hampers'. The whole community is engaging in this initiative and donations will be accepted via the school office or at the Church foyer on weekends.

Just like the loaves and fishes, we can make a difference. The pandemic has affected our communities in many ways. Asylum seekers and refugees have been severely affected as

many have no access to jobkeeper and jobseeker, have lost their jobs, cannot pay their rent and are facing homelessness, struggling to feed their families and facing destitution.

The Jesuit Refugee Service helps support over 900 clients per week. Many of these people are struggling due to the lockdown and lack of government support.
