

DATES TO REMEMBER	Dear St Oliver's Parents and Carers,		
NOVEMBER	As the stores reopened post-lockdown we were welcomed with Christmas carols and the sale of Christmas decorations (in October!!). Many are talking about putting up their Christmas tree in preparation for December 1st. But as Christians there is a special season that precedes Christmas, Advent.		
Friday 26th Stage 3 Leadership Afternoon	This Sunday 28th November marks the start of Advent. It is a season of joy and hope and when thinking about the last six months, each of us have much to hope for. We must be careful not to lose sight of the true meaning of the season as the world around us hustles to buy and sell, to have parties and plan vacations. Advent is a time to renew our life in Christ and to thank God for saving us in Jesus; it is a season for asking God to save all people and for praying for peace in the world.		
Friday 10th Christmas Celebration	Advent, from Latin Adventus, means coming. During Advent, we are invited to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Lord – to wait in joyful hope for his return in glory at the end of time and to prepare for the annual celebration of his birth.		
Wednesday 15th	So this Advent Season let us prepare our hearts and homes with the following suggestions:		
St Oliver's Thanksgiving Celebration	<i>Advent wreath.</i> A wreath of evergreens with four candles is prepared. One candle is lit on the first Sunday, and one more on each of the following Sundays.		
Wednesday 15th Last day of Term	<i>Jesse tree.</i> A branch or large plant is decorated with symbols of Christ's ancestors. As each is prepared and hung, the story of this person is told.		
	<i>Advent calendar.</i> A special calendar to mark the days as we move gradually to the celebration of our Saviour's coming.		
	<i>Cards.</i> When buying and sending Christmas cards, let us ensure that they reflect the meaning of the feast. It is the birth of Christ that we are celebrating.		
	<i>Gifts.</i> Instead of being caught up in a whirl of spending, consider giving a book that will lead a person to reflect a little more. Make a donation to a worthy cause in someone's name. Write, call or visit someone who is sick or shut-in.		
	I wish to invite all St Oliver's families to attend mass this Sunday to mark the start of this special liturgical season in our church, Advent.



Parramatta Diocesan Primary students enrolled in Year 5 and 6 in 2022 are invited to participate in the Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials during Term One & Two in 2022. *Students in Year 4 in 2022 MAY nominate for the sports of Basketball, Hockey, Softball, Tennis & Touch Football only.*

It is important to note that these trials are generally for those students that **MUST** demonstrate an **ABOVE AVERAGE** ability, **HIGH LEVEL OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT** or in particular sports demonstrate **REPRESENTATIVE** playing experience in their nominated sport. In most sports, students should have experience playing regular competition outside of school.





