DATES TO REMEMBER	Dear Parents and Carers,
JUNE	Each year schools are required to formally report on student progress and achievement to parents and carers. Today students and their parents will receive the Semester 1 Reports digitally via Compass.
Thursday 23rd June School Photos Friday 24th June Whole School Mass 10am Feast Day of the Sacred Heart of Jesus	These reports are the culmination of ongoing assessments and classroom observations captured throughout the last term and a half of school. Whilst we acknowledge that teaching and learning was disrupted by the ongoing COVID-19 virus and this year's flu season, the report does provide families with insight into how your child is progressing at school so far this year.
Monday 27th June Athletics Carnival Tuesday 28th June Subway Meal Deal Wednesday 29th June Stage 3 Boys Soccer Gala Day	The Semester 1 Report provides grades and effort scales for the seven subject areas taught at school. More specifically teachers have identified your child's strengths in Religious Education, Mathematics and English. Teachers have also identified areas for improvement specific to your child. To conclude, our Semester 1 Reports also inform parents about the learner qualities that your child has displayed. Again, students and teachers set goals about which learner quality your child continues to develop.
Friday 1st July TERM 2 CONCLUDES	The process of reporting also includes our Parent Teacher Interviews , coming up in Week 10 of this term. The interviews provide teachers and parents (and where possible students) the opportunity to further discuss your child's learning goals and for teachers to provide parents with student samples and evidence of work which support your child's progress this semester. This opportunity to engage in meaningful communication with parents about learning is key to strengthening family partnerships with the school.
	We strongly encourage parents to sit with their child to discuss their progress. Keeping in mind that the reports provide a 'point in time' description of student achievement, progress and growth, we urge parents to praise their child's successes. Keep in mind that "C" is for CELEBRATE and that a key part of achieving one's next steps is - EFFORT . As we all know, learning occurs incrementally along a learning continuum however the rate and pace of learning is not fixed or constant. As such, remember to make your conversations specific to your child when discussing their report.
	All parents and carers are invited to join us for Parent Teacher Interviews in Week 10. We look forward to collaborating at this meeting. <i>"Satisfaction lies in the effort not in the attainment, full effort is full victory!!</i>

Communication between school and parents


Gospel

REFLECTION

Saint Patrick is famous for making the shamrock a handy tool to illustrate the Blessed Trinity: one plant, three leaves that are all connected and united – symbolising the one God, three persons that are all connected and united.

Sometimes close relationships are also compared to the Trinity: the person you love, the person who loves you, and God. If God is a part of your relationship, it's hard to think of the two of you without the power, joy and courage that God brings. Do you have any relationships like that? What are they like?

A family, a team or a close group of friends can also form a community of love that is similar to the Trinity – several persons that are connected and united in a very special way. Do you belong to any such group? If so, what makes it special?

The Holy Spirit brings the truth of God. Sometimes in our life we are running away from a truth, or trying to ignore or avoid it. What basic truth in your life do you think God wants you to be more aware of?

Sometimes in our life, when we have done something wrong or when we are about to do something wrong, the Spirit of God speaks to us through our conscience. Have you ever thought about doing something, until that voice inside you called you to do something else? What happened?

The main message of every Gospel is to know the way of the Spirit and to follow the way of the Spirit. How easy is it to live your life that way? How is living your life that way similar to preaching the Gospel?

How Do I access Compass? Compass Web Access

1. Compass is accessible on your web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safari) and/or by using the Compass iOS or Android apps. To access the parent portal, you can go to our school's website and click the Compass link on their homepage. Alternatively, you can go to <u>https://schools.compass.education/</u> where you can search for our school's direct URL. You can access information about your child here as well as put in Absence notes.

To log in you will require your unique family username and password. These details have been provided to you by our school by email (please check your emails). Upon first login, you will be required to change your password and confirm your email address and mobile phone number. These details may be used by our school for SMS, password recovery and email communication throughout the year.

2.To download the app, please go to the App store on your device and search for Compass School Manager in the store. You will receive all messages from the school and also absence notifications.


